*The London Heathrow pick-up and drop-off service runs on a timetable with pre-planned pick-up and drop-off times at Terminal 5. Students must book their flights to fit with the pick-up and drop-off times. All students must contact the school for the details of the service prior to booking their flights. Details are available from the Registrar.
